

FACTS WHAT DOES TRIPLE-S VIDA DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all, sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social Security Number and Income ▪ Insurance Claim History and Checking Account Information ▪ Medical Information and Employment Information
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Triple-S Vida, Inc. chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do

How does Triple-S Vida, Inc. Protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Triple-S Vida, Inc. Collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Open an account or deposit money ▪ Apply for insurance or pay insurance premiums ▪ File an insurance claim We also collect your personal information from others, such as consumer reporting agencies, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sharing of affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ▪ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Our affiliates include companies with a Triple-S name.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Triple-S Vida, Inc. does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Triple-S Vida, Inc. does not jointly market with nonaffiliated financial companies.</i>
